Conflict Minerals Statement

Vaga Industries is a global company, and we are committed to responsible global citizenship and the protection of human rights around the world. As a part of our international compliance efforts, we have established a conflict minerals compliance program that has been designed and implemented to follow the framework created by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (“OCED”).

Our Company is fully engaged in implementing required aspects of this program. Therefore, Vaga Industries has committed to working with our global supply chain management function to ensure compliance with the OCED framework as well as the United States’ conflict minerals rules, as defined by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”).

As such, our Company will take the necessary steps to ensure that the Company’s sourcing of tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold will originate from conflict-free supply chains. The Company now requires suppliers to undertake reasonable due diligence to determine if the specified metals are being sourced from conflict-free smelters, and if not, to make deliberate progress towards doing so. Our supplier agreements include conflict mineral due diligence and reporting requirements. If the Company becomes aware of the use of conflict minerals in our supply chain, we will work with our suppliers to find alternative conflict-free sources.

We hope that our compliance with SEC regulations regarding Conflict Minerals will continue to promote global humanitarian effort.
